Reading Recovery Teacher Training	£1,278.00	Training to enable the SENCO to train other staff in specific reading strategies to support struggling readers.
Beanstalk Reading Project	£1,712.00	Pupils who need additional reading experience are given 1:1 reading twice a week. This gives broadens the range of reading opportunities pupils
