Sport Funding Report September 2018-July 2019	
Total number of pupils on roll at Autumn 2018 census	168
Total number of eligible pupils for Pupil Premium Funding	90
Total amount of Sports Funding £16,000	amount spent on PE extra curricula activities £15,786

- **Employing a local coach to provide weekly after school sport on the school site**
- **Providing cover to release primary teachers for professional development in PE and sport**
- Introducing new initiatives such as basic movement skills in the Early Years Foundation Stage, or developing young sports leaders in Key Stage 2.
- **Buying into existing local sports networks such as school sport partnerships or community sports coaching initiatives.**
- Forging links with PE teachers in local secondary schools to help primary staff improve their PE and sports provision.
- Providing training and payment for midday supervisors to introduce playground games at breaks and lunchtimes.
- **Establishing a house system to enable regular, inter-house sports competitions for pupils of all ages.**
- **Providing extra, additional activities such as outdoor and adventurous activities.**
- Buying quality-assured professional development modules or materials for PE and sport
- **Providing places for pupils on after school sports clubs and holiday clubs**
- Pooling the additional funding with that of other local schools for joint PE and sport ventures.
- **Employing specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work alongside teachers when teaching PE**
- **Supporting and engaging the least active children through new clubs (e.g. Gardening and Healthy eating)**
- **Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport**
- Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games

The bullet points highlighted in blue are where Christ Church has chosen to focus the funding for 2018-19

2 x Lunchtime Sports Clubs 4 x Curriculum Sessions After School Sports Clubs including: 2 x Football (KS1/KS2) Netball inter-school tournaments	£4,500.00	To improve fitness provide an opportunity to practise football, netball and mixed game skills with the aim of participating in local competitions.
Healthy Eating Club	£1,390.00	6 pupils each term have the opportunity to cook and eat healthy recipes. The produce from the garden is used where possible.
Swimming lessons Y2 x 3 terms Y3, Y4 x 2 terms Y5 Y6 x1 term.	£5,500.00	Starting swimming earlier to make sure pupils have confidence in the water and can swim at least 10 metres by the end of KS1. Teachers gain an understanding of teaching early swimming. Teachers develop their understanding by observing the lessons each week and team teaching where appropriate.
Adventurous Activity Sessions for Y4, 5, 6 at Surrey Outdoor Learning Centre High Ashurst plus Year 3 Boxhill visit.	£3,026.00	Sessions at High Ashurst to develop confidence, risk-taking, perseverance and working as a team.
Dance Around the World	£1,370.00	Pupils to learn different dance styles from around the world. Staff to develop their teaching of dance by observing the session and then teaching the following sessions that lead to performance.
